

Adding Sprayer To Phoenix Cruiser Toilet

Thetford Aqua Magic V Hand Flush

In the years of RVing before buying our 2910D we were accustomed to a having a spray with the toilet. We missed it. Wiping out the toilet by hand is distasteful. Fortunately, the adding of a spray proved to be surprisingly simple and inexpensive. It now looks like this:



The trick is discovering that the Aqua Magic V provides an extra hose connection in back on the valve unit. This barbed nipple extends downward and becomes available by snipping off the tip. (I also reamed the opening a bit because it was slightly pinched in the snipping process).

The sink spray-head/hose package I found in WalMart, Home Depot, Lowes and Amazon for \$11 - \$15 under brand names of Peerless, Danco and Waxman.

The hanger is AquaSource "Plastic Wall Mount", White or Beige at Lowes. \$8.

Decide exactly where you want the wall mount and cut the hose length appropriately.

← Next, slip a hose clamp onto the sprayer hose, push the hose onto the nipple and secure with the hose clamp. That's it! Done.
